HOSTEL

OBJECTIVE

Hostel residents are encouraged to excel academically and engage actively in co-curricular and extra-curricular pursuits, fostering a well-rounded personal and social growth.

ADMISSION

Students are granted admission to the hostel subsequent to securing admission to the college and fulfilling all specified requirements, including the payment of requisite hostel fees.

To become a member of the hostel, students must satisfy all stipulated conditions and complete the necessary administrative procedures, which includes the submission of photocopies of their School Leaving Certificate mark-sheet, Community Certificate, Blood Group Certificate, and, for Catholic students, a letter from the relevant Parish Priest.

Senior students are required to renew their hostel membership annually, particularly at the commencement of each academic year.

Parents or guardians are expected to accompany their wards during the admission process.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Hostel rooms are designated solely for accommodation and academic activities.
- Students are required to stay and sleep exclusively in their assigned rooms during nighttime.
- Permission from the Hostel warden is necessary for any absence from the hostel premises.
- Access to hostel rooms is restricted to registered hostellers only; non-residents, including day-scholars, visitors, and parents, are not permitted entry.
- Students are allocated specific rooms by the warden and are prohibited from changing rooms independently. Room changes can only be authorized by the Director for administrative purposes.
- Students are responsible for maintaining cleanliness and safety in their allotted rooms and the hostel premises, and are prohibited from adding or removing items without the Hostel Warden's permission.
- Any damage to hostel property will result in serious consequences, including compensation for the damage.
- Students must ensure their rooms are locked when leaving.
- The use of specific electrical appliances such as iron boxes, transistors, tape recorders, and table lamps is not permitted in the rooms.
- Students may use fans during study hours and at night for sleeping, with a nominal monthly fee.
- Mobile phones without cameras are permitted within specified times; unauthorized use will result in confiscation and disciplinary action.
- Laptops are allowed with explicit permission, obtained through payment and approval from the Director; unauthorized use will lead to confiscation and consequences.
- Unauthorized use of electrical connections will be subject to severe penalties.
- Students will be assigned to rooms for comfortable accommodation.
- Upon vacating rooms, hostellers must obtain a Room Stock Verification Certificate from the Hostel Warden and rectify any damage or losses.

- Water conservation is emphasized; students are urged to use water sparingly.
- Clothes washing is permitted only during specified hours on holidays.
- Washing clothes and bathing after 9:00 p.m. are strictly prohibited
