The PG and Research Department of English organizes semester-wise activities for the students. The Department inspires and motivates them to improve their skills and participate in various programs. The department has organized seminars, value-added courses, certificate courses, and guest lectures for the students during the academic year 2023–24. The department has also produced Ph.D. scholars during the academic year. The Department of English conducts an orientation for the freshers for three days. This program gives the students insight, helps them pursue their studies, and may give them a clear idea of literature. The faculty members covered all topics of literature.

Welcoming the freshers is a tradition of our Department. The Freshers' Day was organised by the II and III-year UG and PG students on September 15, 2023. Dr. G. Sivabalan, the Head of the Department of English, welcomed and greeted the first-year students. The faculty members of English and various departments felicitated the students and motivated them. The PG Literary Association has its inauguration ceremony on August 4, 2023. The head of the department welcomed the gathering. Dr. M. Elongovan, Associate Professor of English, Thiagarajar College, Madurai, was invited as the chief guest. He inaugurated and delivered a lecture on Contemporary Theory: The Need and the Deed.

The department has organized a One-Day National Seminar on Current Trends in Literature, Theory and Practice: Perspectives and Prospective on October 6, 2023. Prof. R.S. Vignesh was the organizing secretary of the seminar. Dr. Kunhammad KK, Professor and Dean, Faculty of Language and Literature, Kannur University, was the resource person for the morning session and delivered the keynote address on the Uses of Literature and Theory in the New Millennium. Dr. M. Elangovan, Associate Professor, PG, and Research Department of English, Thiagarajar College, Madurai, was the resource person for the afternoon session and delivered the valedictory address on Theory and After: An Appeasement of Chaotic Critiques. All faculty members participated and presented papers at various National and International conferences, and they have published articles in various journals.

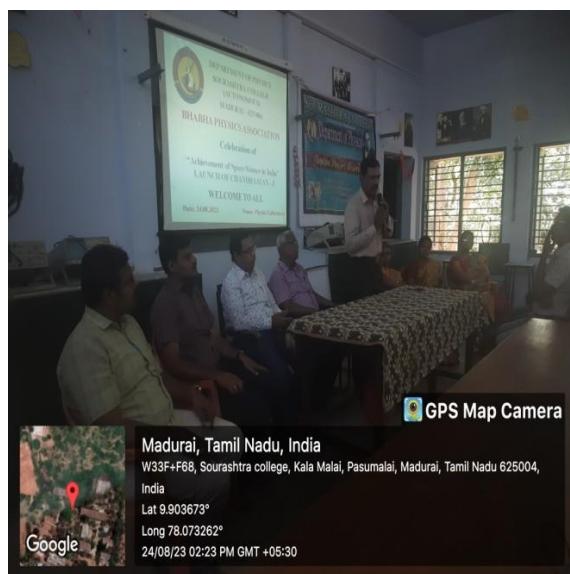
## DEPARTMENT OF MATHEMATICS

#### முன்னுரை:

தனித்தமிழில் தன் பெயரை மாற்றிக் கொண்ட பெருமகனார். தன் செந்தமிழ் நடையால் தமிழ் மனங்களில் நீங்காத இடத்தைப் பிடித்தவர். அத்தகு பெருமையுடைய பரிதிமாற்கலைஞரின் தமிழ்த் தொண்டைப் பற்றிக் காண்போம்.

#### பிறப்பு:

சூரிய நாராயண சாஸ்திரி என்னும் இயற்பெயர்க் கொண்ட பரிதிமாற்கலைஞர் மதுரை மாவட்டத்தில் விளாச்சேரியில் ஜூலை 6, 1870 அன்று பிறந்தார். கோவிந்த சிவனார் மற்றும் இலட்சுமி அம்மாளுக்கும் மூன்றாவது மகனாகப் பிறந்தார்.

#### கல்வி மற்றும் கல்விப் பணி:

பரிதிமாற்கலைஞர் தமது பத்து வயது வரை தன் தந்தையிடம் வடமொழியும் தமிழும் பயின்றார். மேலும், சிறு வயதில் சிலம்பம், மற்போர் கற்றார். 1880-ல் பள்ளியில் சேர்ந்து க.சபாபதி என்பாரிடம் தமிழ் பயின்றார். 1890-ல் சென்னை கிறிஸ்தவக் கல்லூரியில் சேர்ந்தார். 1893-ல் பி.ஏ. தமிழ், லாஜிக் இரண்டிலும் முதல் மாணவராக தேர்ச்சி பெற்றார். 1894-ல் அங்கேயே தமிழாசிரியராக சேர்ந்தார். மேலும், அங்கு தலைமை தமிழ்ப்பண்டிதராக பணிபுரிந்தார்.

#### தமிழ்த்தொண்டு:

- மதுரையில் நான்காம் தமிழ்ச்சங்கம் நிறுவியவர்களுள் இவரும் ஒருவர்.
- அவர் காலத்தில் பல்கலைக்கழக பாடத்திட்டத்தில் தமிழை நீங்கி வடமொழியை கொண்டு வர முடிவு செய்தனர். ஆனால், பரிதிமாற்கலைஞரின் உறுதியான எதிர்ப்பால் பல்கலைக்கழகம் முடிவை கைவிட்டது.
- தமிழில் வடமொழியின் செல்வாக்கை நீக்கும் நோக்கில் உருவான தனித்தமிழ் இயக்கத்தில் முனைப்புடன் ஈடுபட்டார்.

#### சிறப்பு:

- பரிதிமாற்கலைஞர் தனது நூலான “தனிப்பாசாரத்தொகையில்” பெற்றோர் தமக்கு சூட்டிய வடமொழி பெயரான “சூரியநாராயண சாஸ்திரியை” மாற்றி பரிதிமாற்கலைஞர் என்று மாற்றிக் கொண்டார்.
- தமிழ் பயிலும் ஆர்வமிக்க மாணவர்களுக்கு தன் இல்லத்திலே கற்பித்தது அன்றி, அவர்களை “இயற்றமிழ் மாணவர்கள்” என்றும் பெயரிட்டு அழைத்தார். மேலும்,

இயேசுவை போல் தனக்கும் 12 மாணவர்கள் அமைந்ததாக அவர் சொல்வதுண்டு.

- தமிழை முதன்முதலில் உயர்தனிச் செம்மொழி என்று அறிவித்தார். பின்னாளில் 2004-ல் நடுவனரசு தமிழை செம்மொழியாக அறிவித்தது.
- முன்மொழிப் புலமை மிக்கவர்.
- கல்லூரியில் தன் ஆசிரியர் வில்லியம் மில்லர் டென்னிசன் இயற்றிய “ஆர்தரின் இறுதி” என்னும் நூலில் உள்ள பாடலை கூறி அதில் அன்னப்பறவைக்கு துடுப்பை உவமையாக கூறி, தமிழில் இதுபோன்று உண்டோ எனக் கேட்டார். அதற்கு பரிதிமாற்கலைஞர் கம்பராமாயண குகப்படலத்தில் உள்ள “விடுநனி கடிது” என்னும் பாடல் பாடி பொருள் கூறினார்.
