COMPLETION OF VALUE ADDED COURSE ON YOGA --- REPORT


PG and Research Department of English conducted a Value Added Course in Yoga subject under the heading "Yoga for Health and Immunity" from 14th May 2021 to 21st June 2021 for all UG and PG students of Sourashtra College through Google platform. The first class was inaugurated by Dr.M.R.Rashila, Associate Professor & Head, Department of English and the VAC convened and designed by K.V.Kannan, Asst Prof of English.

It was scheduled for 30 hours class and the class was taken one hour per day for 25 hours as Theory Class and 5 hours for Practical Session, during which the birth and growth of Yoga, preliminary ground exercises, Sun-Salutation, various types of Yogasanas, Pranayama and the fundamentals of Health and Immunity system were taught to students through slides, power point presentations, guest lectures and students demonstration of asanas and pranayama in live video.

The whole syllabus was covered daily between 7:00 am and 8:15 am. The attendance was mandatory for all the students and the rewards were given to the full presenters and quick respondents. Meanwhile, two Guest Lectures were arranged on 03.06.2021 and 12.06.2021 on the topic of Health and Immunity. At the end of the course, an Assessment Test was conducted for all the participants.

The valediction of VAC held on the International Day of Yoga on 21st June 2021 at 7:30 am at the terrace of Assistant Professor K.V.Kannan's apartment, strictly followed the Government procedures, during this pandemic period. The Certificates of Appreciation were given to the assembled students by our College Principal(i/c) Prof N.H.Saravanan, Associate Professor and Head, Dr. M.R.Rashila, Dean of Sourashtra College Mrs. T.N.K.Kavitha and the Faculty Member of Department of English Mr.T.K.Sivakumar. 


Value Added Course on Soft Skill Development




Prof. K.G. Raja Sabarish Babu Assistant Professor, Research Department of Business Administration was the course coordinator.




