

- Must include: Name, Email, Linkedin id, and Phone Number
- Should exclude: Address, Undertaking, and Photograph

Make sure to have key information at the top. Avoid writing it at bottom

3. Avoid this Mistake

- Write a Professional Summary instead of a Career Objective.
- Having a career objective is not a value add for a hiring manager.
- Giving a professional summary gives them a sneal peek of your profile and generates curiosity.

Example: Results-oriented marketing professional with 5+ years of experience developing and executing successful marketing campaigns. Proven ability to drive traffic, generate leads, and increase sales—expertise in digital marketing, social media marketing, and email marketing.

4. Work experience

While writing work experience follow the PAR (Problem, Action, and Result) framework

- Use active verbs
- Quantify your accomplishments
- Use Job-related keywords
- Proofread your resume carefully

5. Learn from the best: Google way of writing pointers

Use XYZ structure

X: Accomplishment.

Y: Result.

Z: What you did?

Example: Increased sales by 15% by developing and implementing a new marketing campaign.

Analysis: This bullet point clearly states the accomplishment (increased sales), the result (15% increase), and what the applicant did to achieve the result (developed and implemented a new marketing campaign).
