ALUMNI MEET 2022

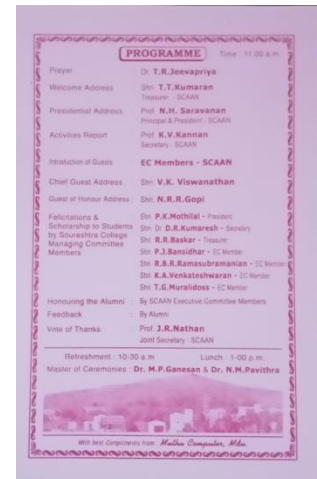
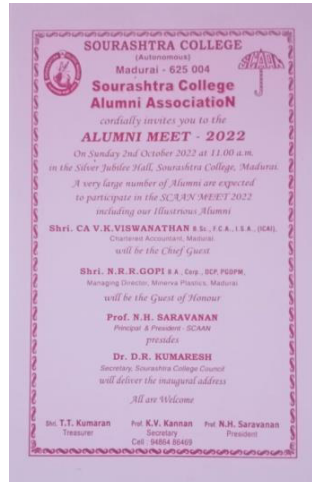

28.03.2023


